Board size" 16" x 23" x 1/2"

PALETTE

John Pike Palette with Lid Reference: Dick Blick Item # 03021-1010

This is a good palette with a tight fitting lid and a large mixing area. The lid also serves as additional mixing space. This palette saves paint for later use. Plus, it travels well.

Should you decide on another type of palette, be sure to look at portability and mixing space. Some palettes will require an additional mixing tray.

Watercolor Notes, Pg. 3

PAINT NOTES: Winsor & Newton Brand

Professional artist grade paints are the best because they contain more pigment, therefore the colors are more intense. Rating: 4.8 out of 5 stars*

Student grade paints contain less pigment and more binders, therefore the intensity of the colors will be affected. Rating: 4.6 out of 5 stars is still a good rating.*

IMPORTANT:

OTHER BRANDS of artist's paints:

If you choose to use another brand, please use the **Color Index Name** to assure that the pigment colors match these W&N colors. Look for this information on the tube.

Note: Color Index Names are the universal names that identify the pigments that are used in each color.

BRUSH NOTES:

Good brushes are essential to good painting practices. A brush that keeps a good point, a good edge, and delivers paint well is extremely important

Brushes that do not hold their shape will have hairs flipping out in every direction. These brushes are a waste of money. Consider this when selecting your brushes.

GATER BOARD NOTES, aka Gatorfoam

This is a foam board that is wood laminated for durability.

It's an excellent work surface for watercolor painting.

Lightweight for easy transport.

Built to last for many years.

Gator Board is highly recommended by both professional and amateur artists throughout the USA.

Hobby Lobby

They may have some of the supplies needed, but they don't have everything that is recommended. I did a price comparison and found Hobby Lobby, even with their coupon, to be higher in price than Dick Blick on identical items. They have some things that can be substituted. Just try to match the supply list as close as possible. Don't forget your *40% off 1 item* coupon.
